## THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

### Attire

- Proper show attire is required for all classes. Collared shirt required for jumpers.
- Helmets must be worn while mounted. **The USEF requires all riders to wear USEF approved head gear.**

### Classes

- Show will be conducted under NIHJA and USEF rules. USEF Equestrian rules apply if not covered by NIHJA.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if necessary.
- Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to list all classes in which they will compete on their original entry form. However, should it be necessary to add a class, please do so no later than 5 PM the day before the class is scheduled to take place.
- Trophy and six ribbons awarded in each class. Championship and reserve awarded in all divisions. You must be entered in the entire division to be eligible for championship and reserve points.
- Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. Multiple rides will be given consideration. **A one minute call will be placed on an open gate.**
- Please observe the dotted line on course when making courtesy circles.

### Stalls

- Stalls are vinyl 10' x 10' with doors. Due to the cost of manure removal, first bedding is **not** included. Shavings must be purchased from horse show management at \$9 per compressed bale.
- Stalls will be available after Noon on Thursday.
- All stalls canceled after 9 a.m. on Monday before the show will be charged to trainers.

### Schooling

- Thursday noon to dusk
- Friday and Saturday to 1 hour before start time. No schooling Sunday morning.
- A warm-up area is available during the show. In addition, a warm-up class will remain open all day. Fence heights will change as show progresses through each day.

### Miscellaneous

- **No smoking in or near any building!**
- A charge of \$50 will be made for returned checks.
- All dogs must be on a leash. Please leave dogs at home if possible.
- Current, negative coggins & proof of flu/rhino vaccine required with all entries.
- Motorized vehicles, carts and scooters must be driven responsibly by a licensed driver.
- **Food will NOT be available on the show grounds. Water bottles will be provided by the in gate areas.**

## \$500 Cross Winds Farm Hunter Derby

**Description:** Open to all horses and ponies. Fences to be 2'6" with three option jumps at 2'9" - 3'. Course to consist of a minimum of 10 jumps for the first round and a minimum of 8 jumps for the handy round.

Jumps to consist of authentic, hunt field style jumps in a fully dressed arena. Course to be different from prior classes at the same show. The handy round must include the three option jumps and must include one trot jump and one gallop jump. Opening gates, mailboxes, etc. is permissible. **Each participating derby horse is REQUIRED to enter one FULL division to be eligible for the Hunter Derby.**

**Scoring:** Two judges will be used. Horses receive a numerical score. In the first round, each jump cleared counts as one bonus point added to the horse's overall score. The top 12 horses return for the second round, lowest score to highest. Again, one bonus point is added for each option jump cleared; handiness will be considered in the score.

**Entry Fee:** \$50

**Attire:** Proper attire or hunt attire required

**Prizes:** Embroidered coolers and ribbons to 10th place

**Prize Money:** Will be a percentage of \$500  
1st—30% 2nd—22% 3rd—15% 4th—10% 5th—7% 6th—6% 7th—5% 8th—5%

## Classics

Large Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 8th place. Trophy awarded for 1st place. Results for the following Equitation Classics will be determined by a two-round combined numerical scores. A rider's Equitation trip will be the first round of their Equitation Classic.

**Short/Long Stirrup Equitation Classic:** X's 1'6"

First round is Short, Long, or Rusty Stirrup Equitation (classes 1, 4, or 134)

**Beginner/Limit Rider Equitation Classic:** 2' or 2'3"

First round is Beginner or Limit Children's or Adult Eq. (classes 7, 9, 11 or 13)

**Modified Children's/Adult Equitation Classic:** 2'6"

First round is Modified Children's or Adult Equitation (classes 17 or 19)

**Junior/Amateur Adult Equitation Classic:** 2'9" or 3'0"

First round is Junior or Amateur Adult Equitation (classes 21, 23 or 25)

## COVID 19 Horse Show Guidelines

This is meant as a guide to maintain the safest possible environment for everyone. Updates will be posted online at [www.CrossWindsFarm.net](http://www.CrossWindsFarm.net), on Cross Winds Farm Social Media and throughout the facility with clearly visible signs.

### General

- Social distancing of 6 feet between individuals will be followed, no congregating will be allowed
- The main barn will be closed except for Cross Winds Farm staff and students
- Horse Show staff, officials, volunteers will be wearing face masks and gloves whenever possible
- Show management will be providing staff to thoroughly clean/disinfect bathrooms, and common touch areas throughout each day
- Individual water bottles for exhibitors will be provided near the in-gate area

### Facility - Access & Sanitation

- All Horse Show staff including office staff, in gate, EMT, judges, ring crew, maintenance on the show grounds will have had their temperature checked before beginning work each day. Any staff with a temperature higher than 99.5 will be sent home.
- Anyone who exhibits COVID 19 symptoms or has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID 19 within the last 2 weeks cannot enter the show grounds.
- No more than 10 people will be allowed in any single space (Show Office, schooling rings, In-Gates, and individual barn stabling areas)
- Until further notice, the public, spectators, and any non-essential persons (guests, friends, family members) will be prohibited from being on the show ground to minimize the number of people.
- Any junior rider competing will be allowed to have ONE parent or guardian with them on the show grounds.
- Participants are required to wear a face mask or face covering when in any setting where there is a possibility of being within 6 ft of other individuals and not mounted on a horse. *\*A participant may choose to wear a facemask or face covering when mounted on a horse and cannot be disqualified or penalized for doing so while competing*
- Show management will be providing hand sanitizing stations near the show secretary set up and at the in-gates

### Stabling Areas – Access & Sanitation

- Access to stabling areas will be restricted to essential personnel; trainers, riders, grooms, veterinarians
- Show Management will arrange stabling to accommodate adequate Social Distancing between trainer groups when possible
- Trainers are required to be responsible for their staff and customers, monitor temperatures and provide masks, gloves, hand sanitizer and other cleaning/disinfecting products for their staff and customers to use while on the show grounds.
- Trainers will be responsible for cleaning/disinfecting their own stabling area; tools, hose ends, gate latches, crosstie snaps, wheelbarrows, and any other frequently handled surfaces.

### Horse Show Office

- All entries, vaccination records and negative Coggins should be sent electronically to Horse Show Management as listed in the prize list
- Trainers will be responsible for checking in and checking out their customers at a prearranged time at the show office to minimize office traffic
- Any adds and/or scratches will be done at the in-gate
- Ribbons and prizes will not be handed out at the ring
- All feed and shavings orders must be arranged with Show Management prior to arrival

## New divisions this year!

**Rusty Stirrup Hunter**—Open to riders 36 years and over. Riders may cross enter in the Beginner Rider Division, Amateur Adult Hunter U/S, Novice Hunter U/S, Amateur Adult Equitation Flat, Non-Pro Hunter U/S, Limit Rider Hunter U/S. Warm up rounds may be allowed at the discretion of the Show Management provided it is announced prior to the start of the O/F class. Martingales are allowed in all Rusty Stirrup classes.

**Rusty Stirrup Equitation**—Open to riders 36 years and over. Riders may cross enter in the Beginner Rider Division, Amateur Adult Hunter U/S, Novice Hunter U/S, Amateur Adult Equitation Flat, Non-Pro Hunter U/S, Limit Rider Hunter U/S. Warm up rounds may be allowed at the discretion of the Show Management provided it is announced prior to the start of the O/F class. Martingales are allowed in all Rusty Stirrup classes.
