Show Information

Stabling: 10' x 10' vinyl stalls with doors, no outside bedding is allowed. Additional shavings \$12.00 per bag, but must be listed on original prize list and paid for with entry.

Derby Days is limited in the amount of horses allowed in order to finish the show during limited fall daylight hours. All horses must have a stall. **NO NON-COMPETING HORSES.** Tack stalls \$150.00. Entry must have a Negative Coggins and Proof of FLU/RHINO VACCINATION WITHIN 6 MONTHS.

Schooling the derby course is permitted Friday ONLY from 1pm to 7pm. There is no schooling Saturday or Sunday in the show arena. Natural obstacles similar to the actual derby jumps will be available in 2 warm up arenas for unlimited schooling.

Course: 300' x 250' arena. Jumps to consist of authentic, hunt field style jumps in a fully dressed arena. Course will consist of a minimum of 10 jumps for the first round and a minimum of 8 jumps for the handy. Jumper courses will have a minimum of 8 jumping efforts in the first round and 6 jumping efforts in the jump off.

Scoring Hunters: Horses receive a numerical score for each round. The two scores are then added together for a total score for that class. Hunter rounds will be scored as a typical Derby class, judged on accuracy and performance. Each course will have at least 3 option fences and riders will receive 1 bonus point per option attempted. Handy Rounds on Sunday will be at least 8 fences with at least 2 option fences. Handiness will be factored into the score.

Jumpers: Riders will ride in the same arena over derby style jumps and colored rails. Class #5 and #6 will be awarded points the same as a traditional two class jumper division earning points over both days to determine Champion thru 8th place. If there is a tie for Champion, the rider's jump off times from both days will be combined. The rider with fastest overall time will earn the Champion.

Attire: Proper show attire is suggested for all classes. Helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.

Ribbons & Prizes: Embroidered Coolers for overall 1st place, cash payouts and ribbons First thru Eighth place for classes 1-6 will be awarded Sunday for overall placings. **In addition, the top 6 riders of each round each day will also be pinned.**

Cash Percentage is as follows:

1st – 30%; 2nd – 22%; 3rd – 15%, 4th – 10%, 5th – 7%, 6th – 6%, 7th – 5%, 8th – 5%.

There will **NOT** be a secretary at the show. All entries **MUST** be paid after you are notified of entry acceptance, Shavings can **NOT** be added at the show and classes can **NOT** be added.
Classes entered, but not ridden in will **NOT** be refunded.
Riders will be given a number and class order upon arrival.

Entries: Riders may scratch classes; however, entry fees are non - refundable after the closing date.

Order of Go: Each class will have a posted order of go that will be posted online Thursday, October 8, 2026. Adding classes will NOT be allowed once the schedule is posted. Classes may be scratched, but will NOT receive a refund without a vet slip.

Directions: Take 1-90 to the Marengo/Route 20 Exit, Turn Left. Cross Winds Farm is located 4 miles on the left (half mile past the Blackstone subdivision.)

Miscellaneous: A charge of \$50 will be made for returned checks. All dogs must be on a leash. Please leave dogs at home, if possible. Motorized vehicles, carts, and scooters must be driven responsibly by a licensed driver.

Class Information:

- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if necessary.
- Class #2 (2'3" Jr/Am Hunter Riders) can only cross enter into class #1 or #3.
- Sharing a horse is allowed (horses are allowed to have 2 or more riders at the show), however a horse may only perform in each class ONCE.
- Each horse is required to ENTER into a minimum of 2 classes.
- Saturday is the first round for derby riders, Sunday is the handy round. ALL RIDERS are eligible to ride in the handy round (to be ridden on Sunday), regardless of first round score or completion. **(this is NOT a top 12 callback).**
